

# **Grommets - Post operative instructions**

### Before your child's surgery

- Grommet insertion is usually carried out in hospital. It is a day only procedure so your child will not necessarily need to stay overnight unless they are having another operation for example, tonsillectomy at the same time.
- Remember to let school know your child will be off for 24 hours.

### After your child's surgery

- Discomfort-grommet insertion is not generally painful, panadol or nurofen for the first 24 hrs should suffice. You should contact us if there is a lot of pain after the operation.
- Ear Discharge small amounts of watery and bloodstained discharge are normal for the first 3 days. (If there is lots of discharge, it is smelly or green, or if there is blood that trickles from the ear contact us and we will advise.
- Ear Drops- antibiotic drops are placed in the ear canal at the time of operation. If the ear is very infected Dr McGuinness will prescribe a further course of eardrops.
- Keep the Ears Dry you need to be careful of water getting in the ears. For the first 2 weeks we advise protecting the ears with cotton wool when bathing or showering.

- Swimming- Your child should not swim for 2 weeks after the surgery. Children with grommets can swim after this but we would advise protecting the ears with earplugs and a headband or a swimming cap.
- Ear Infections- children with grommets can still get ear infections especially if dirty water gets into the ears or if they have a cold. These infections are not usually painful and your child will not feel unwell. The best way to treat them is often with eardrops such as Ciloxan rather than with oral antibioics.

#### Post operative appointments

You will receive a call from our nurse around 3 days after discharge and an appointment will be made for 3-4 weeks after surgery.
